HIGH MINNIS ROAD, STELLING

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that High Minnis Road, Stelling will be closed to through traffic, on or after 6th February 2023 for up to 12 days.

The road will be closed between The Lord Whiskey Tea room and Park Wood.

The alternative route is via Mockbeggar, Sandy Lane and Eastleigh Court Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:30 and 15:30 each day.

This closure is necessary to enable a dangerous tree to be taken down by Response TM.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
