BOSSINGHAM ROAD, STELLING MINNIS

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow telegraph pole testing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bossingham Road, Stelling Minnis, in the Folkestone & Hythe area.

An off-peak closure is planned for Wednesday 29 September 2021 between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours.

Bossingham Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the property Four Winds, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Curtis Lane, B2068 Stone Street, Lime Kiln Lane and The Street.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
